2. Application requirements

1. Applicants with the aspirations of studying in higher education institutions in Japan like universities, postgraduate programs or professional training colleges. (Preparation 2 year • 1 year 9 months • 1 year 6 months • 1 year 3 months course)

A person who satisfies all the following 1) to 10)

1. A person who has completed 12 years or more of school education or an equivalent course.
2. A person who is 18 years of age or older at the time of enrollment at this university.
3. A person with a clear purpose for studying abroad and future plans, and intends to pursue further education at a university, vocational school, or similar institution.
4. A person who has studied Japanese for 150 hours or more (equivalent to the A1 level of the Japanese language proficiency scale). However, for students enrolling in October or January, the A2 level is acceptable.
5. A person who has a reliable guarantor (financial supporter).
6. A person who is physically and mentally healthy, with no chronic illness that would make it difficult to continue studying abroad.
7. A person who does not have tattoos.
8. A person who has been granted permission to enter Japan through proper procedures or is expected to be granted permission.
9. A person, including their family and relatives, who has not been subjected to penalties for illegal stay or criminal activities in Japan in the past.
10. A person who has not entered Japan as a technical intern trainee in the past two years.

3. How to apply

Students who want to enter first must take a screening examination.

1. Application for Admission Selection Exam

Those who wish to enroll are required to submit the application form, resume, statement of purpose for studying abroad, financial support statement, and proof of Japanese language proficiency (e.g., certificates for those who possess them) to Nagoya Nissei Japanese Language School via email. After receipt of the documents, details regarding the exam date, venue, etc., will be provided separately. Please refer to "7. Payment of Fees and Bank Transfers" for information on the selection fee.

2. Application period

April Admissions	Each year from July to August 31 st
July Admissions	Each year from November to December 31 st
October Admissions	Each year from February to March 31 st
January Admissions	Each year from May to June 30 th

3. Exam content

4. Submission of Application Documents (After Passing the Admission Selection Exam)

Those who receive notification of passing the admission selection exam must submit the following documents. Please note that failure to submit the required documents by the deadline, or submission of documents with discrepancies may result in the cancellation of your acceptance.

1. Applicants documents

1) Documents designated by the school

Application form, Resume, Statement of Reasons for attendance

2) Documents needed to be prepared by the issuing authority

Document proving Japanese proficiency, Certificate of Graduation, transcript, a copy of your passport, a copy of birth certificate, other documents if requested by the school.

3) 10 photographs

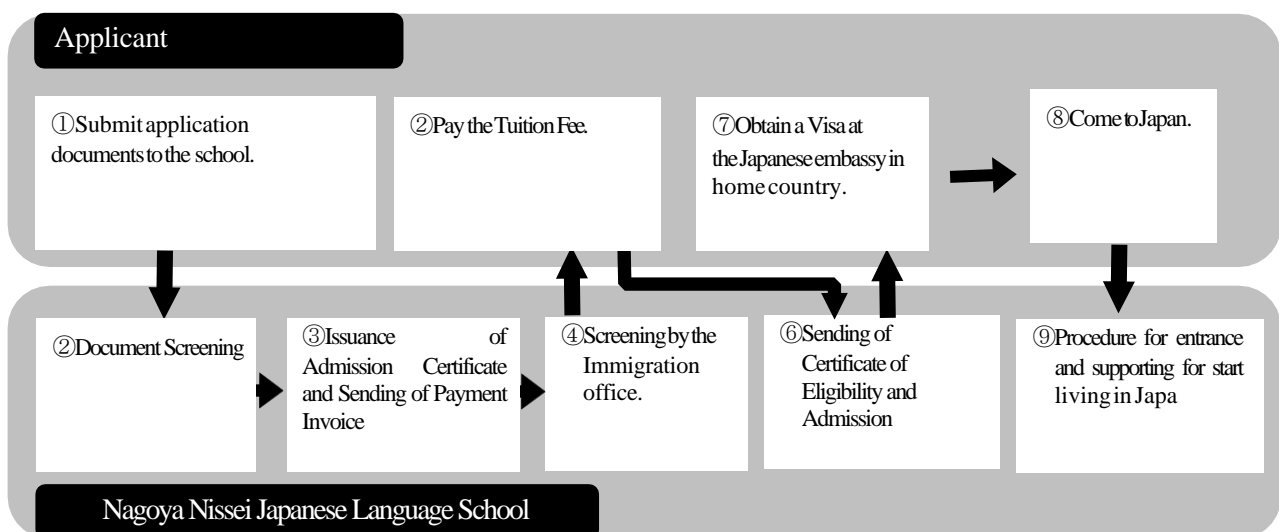
2. Documents proving the ability to pay tuition and life expenses

1) Documents designated by the school Financial Statement

2) Documents needed to be prepared by the issuing authority

Documents proving financial capability and the process of asset formation (e.g., bank balance certificate, copies of bank passbooks showing the financial history for the past three years, employment certificate, tax certificate, etc.), documents verifying the relationship between the financial sponsor and the applicant (e.g., notarized certificate of kinship), and any other documents deemed necessary by the school.

6. Dormitory

Nissei Japanese Language School Nagoya are fully equipped with dormitories around the school for international students to live with peace of mind in Japan. Students move into the dormitories and go to school from there.

1. Regarding the move-in

- 1) The students must stay in the dormitories for 6 months since they move into there. They can move after 6 months.
- 2) The furniture and electrical appliances such as refrigerator, washing machine, air conditioner, rice cooker, gas stove and dining table are available for free use.
- 3) Free bicycle rental available. Free Internet Wi-Fi connection.

2. Regarding Fees

- 1) A fee of 29,000 yen will be required upon move-in. *Please pay this amount along with the tuition fees.*
- 2) A monthly rent of 29,000 yen will be charged.
